PROVA ESTRATTA NUM 2

The individual is a male between 25 and 35 years of age and with a beard and black hair. Fractures on various parts of the thorax were not necessarily acquired before his death. Linear tattoos on his back and behind one knee must have had a magic-therapeutic significance since they are found in correspondence with pathological manifestations (arthritis). Heavily worn teeth combined with a lack of other pathologies suggest the consumption of hard or uncooked food mixed with siliceous fragments or particles (use of grindstones, consumption of badly washed food or coarse flour). The radiometric dates carried out on a fragment of human flesh at various laboratories have enabled the body to be dated to a period comprised between 3000 and 3300 years ago.

PROVA NON ESTRATTA NUM 1

The karstic cavity, which is rich with concretions, develops for about 65 metres into the dolomitic limestone. The main room ("Sala del Focolare") lies at 15 metres from the current entrance, after a modest entrance area and an access corridor. Here a mesolithic living-floor measuring 45 square metres was discovered, rough and uneven; and partially concreted. It is covered by numerous remains of Ibex and Red Deer which are well preserved and there is a large next to a big mass of rock fall close to the rock wall. The excavations revealed the presence of a stratigraphic sequence.

The lithic industry is scarce and is constituted nearly exclusively by geometric microliths (12 trapezoidal segments, truncated backed bladelets, segments and triangles, one core and two retouched flakes). Flaking at the site has not been documented.

PROVA NON ESTRATTA NUM 3

The oldest phases in human evolution and the most ancient fossils attributable to the genus *Homo* found in Africa and Europe are demonstrated with casts. Lower and Middle Palaeolithic Mousterian industries from Grotta del Broion near Lumignano and Grotte di san Bernardino near Mossano document the earliest presence of humans on the Berici Hills. These and other caves (Grotta di Pina near Mossano, Covolo Fortificato di Trene) also have Upper Palaeolithic industries (Aurignacian, Gravettian, early Epigravettian). Würm Late Glacial mountain sites with late Epigravettian lithic industries are represented by the site of "Fiorentini" on the Tonezza plateau.
